Thank you for your Freedom of Information request which was received within the Trust.
Please note, this is a response for **Bedford site only**.

You asked:

Since November 1st 2020:

- 1. How many people have required admission to hospital as a result of pregnancy loss in all forms?**

Between the period 1 Nov 20 and 30 Jun 22, there were 595 admissions where the primary diagnosis were in O00-O08 series. There were 552 patients.

- 2. Of those people, how many people requiring admission due to pregnancy loss have been admitted to a maternity ward?**

47

- 3. How many people requiring admission due to pregnancy loss in all forms have been allowed to have their partners/support person on the ward/in the room with them?**
