The Chaplaincy Team

The Hospital has one full time chaplain who co-ordinates the chaplaincy work. Chaplains of various denominations and faiths visit part time, or come when requested. Ministers from all the major faiths can be contacted via the Chaplaincy.

This core team is supplemented by a group of committed volunteers who visit wards, push wheelchairs, arrange the flowers, play the organ and care for the Chapel.

The Chaplain's office is on the Ground Floor in the Old Block.
