

Healthcare Databases Advanced Search (HDAS)

Search databases AMED, British Nursing Index, CINAHL, EMBASE, HMIC, MEDLINE, PsychINFO and Health Business Elite <http://www.nice.org.uk/about/what-we-do/evidence-services/journals-and-databases>

AMED

An allied and complementary medicine database. Its main strengths lie in the fields of physiotherapy, occupational therapy, rehabilitation, podiatry, palliative care and speech and language therapy. 1985 to date.

British Nursing Index (BNI)

Subject coverage includes nursing specialties and evidence-based practice. 1994 to date.

CINAHL

The Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature (CINAHL). 1982 to date.

EMBASE

Covers pharmacy and pharmacology, toxicology, public and environmental health, psychiatry and forensic science. It is particularly valuable for drug-related searches. 1974 to date.

HMIC

Comprises DH Data and Kings Fund databases both of which cover UK NHS health services management, policy and standards and social care. 1979 to date.

MEDLINE

It has extensive subject coverage with an emphasis on clinical medicine and biomedical research, but also including dentistry, pharmacology, microbiology, nutrition, health care delivery, psychiatry, psychology and other topics. 1951 to date.

PsycINFO

A major database in the field of psychology. It provides references from over 1,900 journals. 1887 to date.
