Thank you for your Freedom of Information request which was received within the Trust.
In accordance with S.1 (1) (a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), I can confirm that we do hold the information relevant to your request. FOI 350

Between 8 December and 8 January, how many doses of the Pfizer Covid vaccine were administered at each of your hospital vaccination hubs?

- Between 8 December and 8 January, how many doses of the Pfizer Covid vaccine were destroyed/discarded/thrown away at each of your hospital vaccination hubs? Do you have a daily breakdown of these figures? If so, can I be sent these please?

- In those instances where doses were destroyed/discarded/thrown away, what reasons were given for staff not being able to administer them to patients?

Response from Bedfordshire Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust

Between the 8th December 2001 and the 8th January 2021 at the **Bedford hospital site**

464 doses of the Pfizer vaccine were administered

146 on 7th January

318 on 8th January

2 doses of the Pfizer vaccine were destroyed on 7th due to time expiration. No doses were wasted on the 8th

Between the 8th December 2001 and the 8th January 2021 at the **Luton and Dunstable hospital site**

1632 doses of the Pfizer vaccine were administered

133 on 4th January

381 on 5th January

386 on 6th January

355 on 7th January

377 on 8th January

Vials were destroyed at the L&D site as per the following

- 4th no waste
- 5th 1 vial spoiled due to particulate being present
- 6th 1 vial spoiled due to particulate being present
- 7th 2 vials spoiled due to particulate being present
- 8th 2 vials spoiled; 1 due to particulate being present, the other due to a dilution error
