Thank you for your Freedom of Information request which was received within the Trust. Please note, this is a cross-site response for Bedford site and Luton site.

You asked:

I have a query about clotting disorders. Could you please tell me how many patients are registered with your Haemophilia Centre for;

- Von Willebrand Disease adult patients (age 18 or above) 6
- Von Willebrand Disease paediatric patients (age 17 or under) 8
- · Haemophilia B (any age) 1-5
