Thank you for your Freedom of Information request. Please note, this is a cross-site response for Bedford site and Luton site.

You asked:

## FY 22/23

- 1) How many incidents were reported by your Trust on the Datix incident reporting system under the category 'MRI safety'?
- 2) How many of these MRI safety Datix incident reports were listed under the division, 'MRI Non Declared Internal Passive Metallic Implant'?
- 3) How many of these MRI safety Datix incident reports were under the division 'MRI Non Declared Internal Active Metallic Implant'?

For all of the incidents captured under 2 and 3 above in 2022/23, can you please provide a verbatim copy of the description of the adverse event?

L&D	Imaging	MRI scanning Department	The patient was almost taken into the MRI scanner with a permanent pacemaker insitu.	No Harm - Any incident that ran to completion but no harm occurred
L&D	Imaging	MRI scanning Department	The patient arrived for MRI. Their safety questionnaire was completed with radiographer 1. They answered no to all contra indications for MRI with full control. Radiographer 1 and 2 checked for other metallic objects. In the scanner between the two thin sheets over the patient a small infusion pump was discovered which was pulled away from the sheets and attached to the magnet wall by the magnetic field.	No Harm - Any incident that ran to completion but no harm occurred
